

BOUNTY TOURNAMENTS

At one of the first games of the tournament, a coach that is awarded the status of Home Team, will draw a name from a container that will include the name of every team participating in the tournament. The team drawn will then be identified as the “Bounty” team on the bracket board. The team that eliminates the “Bounty” team from the tournament will receive, \$25 for every team that is entered into that particular tournament. If the team that is designated as the “Bounty” team wins the tournament then the “Bounty team will receive the payout.

In a Round Robin format, if the “Bounty” team is eliminated in pool play, the money will be awarded to the last team that beat them.

In the case that a team that is designated as the “Bounty” team does not show up for the tournament, another team will be drawn and identified as soon as this is made evident to the Tournament Director.
